MINUTES

Members present approved the minutes from the October 2010 meeting as published in the October newsletter.

TREASURER'S REPORT

The treasurer's report was presented by Joyce Norquist. Members present approved the report and filed the statement for audit.

NEW BUSINESS

As discussed in a previous e-mail to chapter members, Joe made a motion relative to the proposed 2012 outing schedule. He received seven "proxy" votes on the motion, all voting in favor of the motion, several with added suggestions. All proxies authorized Joe to vote as needed. Good discussion followed on the motion originally made. However, a revised motion was presented which was thoroughly discussed, seconded, and approved by those in attendance. Joe cast the seven proxy votes in favor of the new

proposed outing schedule for 2012 as shown below.

A further motion was made, discussed, seconded, and approved stating that henceforth; our outings will officially begin on a Friday and end on a Sunday. This will not prevent those wishing to attend earlier in the week. Those wishing to arrive earlier than the Friday of the scheduled outing should not expect the wagon master to arrive earlier. Wagon masters, should there be one for an outing, will only schedule events for the Friday to Sunday period.

Dates for the 2012 outings will be made shortly, and if possible, all outings will try to be scheduled at the end of the second week of each month. Once the venues have been confirmed, the schedule will be posted on the chapter's web site, if updated, or will become part of the newsletter.
